

SUMMARY
BUCKEYE LOCAL BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING

The Buckeye Local Board of Education met in special session on February 8, 2007 at 7:00 P.M. In attendance were Mr. DeLuca, Mrs. Kolkedy, Mr. Moore, Mr. Signorini and Mr. Zelek. Also present were Mr. Pielech, Ms. Prebeg, Mr. Donahue, Mr. Closser and CTA and OAPSE representatives.

The Board acted on the following items of business at this special meeting:

1. Adjourned to executive session at 7:30 PM for the purpose of reviewing the appointment, employment, dismissal, discipline, promotion, demotion or compensation of an employee. Reconvened at 8:45 PM.
2. Employed Melissa Runnion as an Elementary Principal (West Elementary) on a one year limited contract effective August 1, 2007.
3. Revised the Management Team Criteria for Salary Schedule. Revision reflects addition of Administrative Assistant/Federal Programs Director position.
4. Declined to accept the resignation of Traci Tuttle, South Elementary Teacher, retroactive to January 16, 2007.
5. Entered into a lease agreement with the Village of Yorkville leasing real estate (World War II Memorial Stadium) to the Village and granting the right to enter upon the real estate for the purpose of constructing an asphalt "walking track".
6. Employed Angela Hicks as Administrative Assistant/Federal Programs Director on a three year limited contract effective July 1, 2007 and extending through July 31, 2010.
7. Accepted the resignation of Joseph W. Pielech as Superintendent effective July 31, 2007.
8. Employed the following people for supplemental duties as indicated for the 2006-07 school year:
